<u>Education Options</u>	<u>Date/Details</u>
1. Place posters with safety information around school or during events such as wellness nights, family nights, parent teacher conferences, etc.	
2. Conduct monthly school bike and pedestrian safety announcements over the loud speaker	
3. Display bicycle and pedestrian safety information for a week/month in school display case	
4. Invite a speaker to speak to classrooms or hold an assembly focused on bicycle and pedestrian safety	
5. Demonstrate the effectiveness of bike helmets by using the egg helmets and Jell-O brains and showing students how their helmet should fit	
6. Hold a bike rodeo or other safety event for students to practice safe walking/riding skills	
7. Include safety tips on Walking School Bus promotional flyers every week	
8. Send home activity sheets that focus on bicycle and pedestrian safety as "homework"	
9. Incorporate bicycle and/or pedestrian safety education into physical education or other class	
10. Participate in International Walk to School Day which emphasizes pedestrian safety	
11. Including a short paragraph in your school's monthly newsletter or send home in take-home folders	
12. Include bicycle and pedestrian safety weekly on the Walking School Bus
